THE FINANCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION

The Financial Services Commission (“FSC”) is advising that Executive Director Brian Wynter tendered his resignation on August 31, 2007 to take effect on December 3, 2007.

Mr Wynter is the first Executive Director of the FSC which came into being in August 2001. The FSC regulates financial services provided to the public in the areas of investments, insurance and pensions. Mr Wynter will be taking up a position as Capital Markets Advisor with the Caribbean Regional Technical Assistance Center (“CARTAC”).

CARTAC is a regional resource, based in Barbados, which provides technical assistance and training in core areas of economic and financial management at the request of its participating countries. The CARICOM Council of Ministers of Finance and Planning took the decision to establish the Centre in September 1999. The Centre became operational in November 2001. CARTAC, which also includes non-CARICOM countries amongst its members, operates as a UNDP project with the International Monetary Fund serving as the executing agency.
